Who?

Students entering grade nine in the Fall 2017.

Students who could use some extra attention in applied or locally developed courses on numeracy and workplace essential skills.

Students who will try to self-reflect and improve themselves in a focused and engaging learning opportunity.

What?

Through hands on experiences this four week program will focus on developing important numeracy skills such as; managing money, schedules, budgets etc. Students will learn how to set goals and develop a process for decision making. Students will be exposed to a variety of technologies while they investigate occupations of interest.

Where?

Peterborough (Adam Scott CVI) and Northumberland (Northumberland CIS, Cobourg) Summer School locations.

When?

July 4th to July 31st, Monday to Friday, 8:30 am to 2:30 pm

Why?

Student will gain a course credit (GLD – Discovering the Workplace). Beginning high school with one credit completed helps ensure success in grade 9 and beyond.

Students will gain practical and transferrable numeracy skills to support them in all of their courses.
